COSTS:

The landowner costs of the shelterbelt service are:

- 1) \$ 100.00 per mile for field shelterbelts with \$100.00 minimum fee.
- 2) \$ 200.00 per mile for yard shelterbelts with \$200.00 minimum fee.
- 3) Plastic mulch \$75/ 500 metre roll (partial cost recovery).

CONDITIONS:

The conservation district shall:

1. Plan the planting to the satisfaction of the landowner.
2. Provide and plant recommended species of trees (From PFRA stock).
3. Supply and install plastic mulch at a cost of \$75 per roll.
4. Provide replanting services in the following year after planting, providing lack of tree survival is due to adverse conditions that are unavoidable.

The landowner shall:

1. Provide a suitable planting site ie: summer fallow strip, and a tractor and driver for planting and application of plastic mulch.
2. Protect the planting from livestock, chemical or fire damage.
3. Maintain the planting for a minimum period of 3 years. **(Maintenance costs are 100% landowner)**
4. Provide weed control as necessary for a minimum of 3 years.
5. Allow reasonable access to project areas for tours or to inspect the condition of the project.
6. Grant the Conservation District the right to use any information related to this project for educational or promotional purposes.
7. Be eligible to receive tree stock from PFRA tree stock, otherwise provide tree stock for planting or pay cost recovery for tree stock provided by the conservation district.

General Terms and Conditions:

- Subject to the above terms, the agreement shall become effective and shall be binding upon both parties.
- If either party fails to meet the above mentioned responsibilities, the agreement may be terminated by the party via written notice.
- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriated.
- Technical service will be subject to the availability of staff. The district reserves the right to establish priorities for providing such services and assistance.
- Failure of Landowner to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him/her from other Conservation District programs.

NOTE:

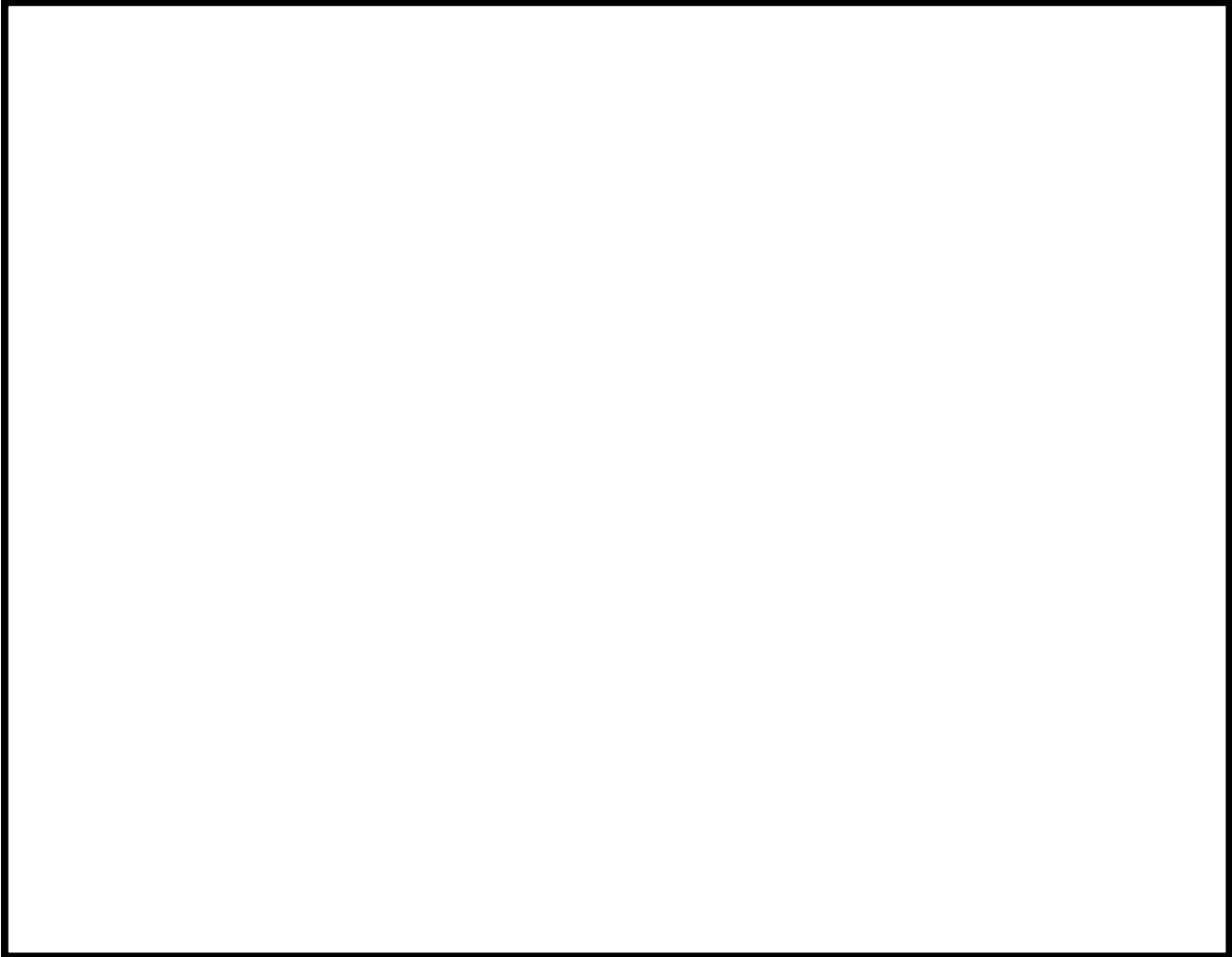
- * District may refuse to plant or replant if landowner refuses to do any of his/her tasks.
- * Apply early for best PFRA tree stock selection.
